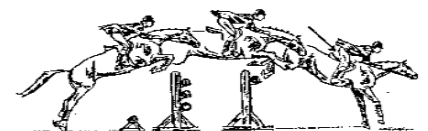

GET TO KNOW HORSE SHOWS IN THE PARK

WE OFFER PROFESSIONAL SHOW MANAGEMENT SAFE, INVITING & BEAUTIFULLY APPOINTED COURSES WITH WELL MAINTAINED FOOTING AND WONDERFUL RIBBONS AND PRIZES !!!

1. Entry fees are \$12.00 per class for pre-entries received prior to 8pm on Tuesday before show; \$15.00 Per class thereafter. Pre-entry requested to aid in staffing/logistical planning. Marshall & Sterling classes and USHJA Medals are \$22.00. W/T Mini Medal, 2' Medal, Savannah and Rose Dhu Hunter Classics are \$15.00. Office \$15.00 per day or \$25.00 Fri/Sat/Sun. Insurance \$5.00. No numbers issued until a signed entry blank has been received and the secretary has received an open check. Current show Back Numbers required for schooling. Stalls \$60.00 for Fri/Sat/Sun. No shavings in stalls; shavings available for purchase; specify on entry how many bags or bring your own. One day (Fri or Sat) stall purchase \$30.00. If trailering in only to school, \$20 + office. Pre-entries/stall reservations due by Tuesday @ 8:00 pm prior to show, all entries thereafter are considered post. 2 day exhibitors get priority for stalls. Stalls available Friday @ 1:00 pm. Entries always cheerfully taken day of show and at the gate.
 2. Schooling Friday at 1:00 p.m. until 5pm for horses/riders registered in the show. Schooling monitored and # of riders in arenas limited to 5. Show office open Fri. 12--5:30, Sat/Sun @ 7:00am., closes 30 min. after last class.
 3. Current Negative Coggins required on all horses on show grounds w/entry. All dogs must be on leash or fined.
 4. Show management reserves the right to refuse entry, combine or cancel classes for any reason.
 5. Polo shirt or sweater, boots, breeches for classes. USEF/ASTM approved headgear required for any person mounted on a horse or pony.
 6. Walk-Trot riders not to have cantered in a show, except for "Walk-Trot-Canter One at a Time".
 8. Limited Concession 9. Ample Trailer Parking 10. Vet/blacksmith on call

GENERAL SHOW AND PRIZE INFORMATION

A \$500 CHECK will be given after the June show to the barn/farm/trainer whose top 5 riders have the most points overall when all the shows points are added up. The Points will be calculated as follows:

- 1st Place = 7
- 2nd Place = 5
- 3rd Place = 4
- 4th Place = 3
- 5th Place = 2
- 6th Place = 1

DID YOU KNOW that at HSITP shows if there are 4 in the class that first place gets a cool trophy or prize? Our ribbons are the biggest and the prizes the neatest... just ask any Florida HSITP rider!! Over 230 riders came to last year's awards banquet in Ocala Florida!!!

Prior to the show's start, each rider must declare their trainer/farm's affiliation on their entry form. No changes are allowed after the show starts! Changes may be made between shows if the show offices are notified in writing, however such changes will not affect previous points. Each rider is limited to riding no more than 5 horses per day. A 3 minute gate hold will be in effect, no matter how many horses the rider is riding in the show.

During each show the points will be posted for everyone to see and announced.

After the final show in June—the points will be added up, the winners notified and a presentation of the \$500 check will be made in July. The winner will receive their check and a trophy with their name on it will be displayed throughout the year at the Low Country Saddlery shop. In addition, each farm/barn/trainer who wins through 3rd place will receive a wonderful plaque for display on the wall of their barn!!

EARN MORE POINTS WITH SPIRIT!!!

As a special incentive to our barns in hot competition—we'll offer 100 points each show—available to the barn that displays the most “team spirit” during the show... this can mean matching t-shirts, saddle pads, horse clothing, cheering, signage, banners, visible signs of great horsemanship displayed toward fellow competitors, feeding of exhibitors, show management, volunteer to put on an equine fashion show at the lunch break, (the possibilities are endless...) and general obvious fun show bribery associated with good sportsmanship. It'll be 50 points to the winner, and 25 points each to second and third place—at each show during the series...judging and evaluation by each show's judge with input from HSITP show staff and gate personnel.

This is an HSITP “Short Circuit Series” circuit of shows. That means *each rider's points will be added up per division after each show, and at the series end we'll announce the Champion and Reserve winners for each division who'll receive some great awards!! Depending on the division, you or the horse/pony must show in 2 out of 3 of the shows' and in the applicable division at least twice to be eligible for the awards...*

ONGOING RECOGNITION OF YOUR FARM AND OUR HSITP HILTON HEAD RIDERS

Look to our broadcast emails (currently 450+ addresses strong in the Hilton Head and surrounding areas now!) to go out before and after each show in order to tell the story on the show's competitors and who's won what! What great advertisement for your barn/trainer or just plain great accolades for your riders!! Info and videos will be shared on an ongoing basis with The Island Packet and local area newspapers and periodicals.

Travel Incentives for Barns Far Far Away!!!

HSITP has announced FREE SATURDAY NIGHT STALLS at Rose Dhu for the barn/trainer who has driven the farthest to get to the show (with a 50 mile minimum).
