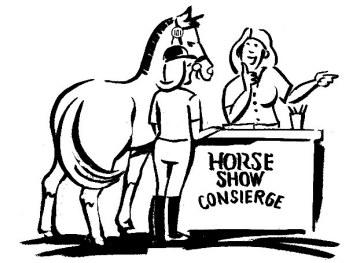

Welcome to Horse Shows in the Park’s newest show series in New Smyrna Beach at the Silver Sands Bridle Club Show Complex. It’s a fun one arena show with classes from Crossrails to 3’. We enjoyed a very successful start in 2018 with 4 shows held, expanded to 6 shows in 2019 and made some adjustments as follows based on our 2018 experience and feedback from riders and trainers:

- ◆ Friday night classes may be held at each show starting at 5:30 Friday with a number of open fence heights divisions. It’s anticipated moving these classes to Friday will enable us to finish at a reasonable hour on Saturday and Sunday.
- ◆ A Suitability for Dressage division has been added for those horses and ponies who may need mileage and exposure to a show environment and demonstrate capabilities as a potential Dressage partner...this class may be ridden in dressage tack, and demonstrate a horse’s roundness, ability to collect and be ridden effectively, respond accurately to the rider’s aids, quality of gait and correctness.
- ◆ Greater emphasis to be provided for volunteer opportunities to offset show fees, from gate duty to jump crew. A Sponsorship Opportunity program is under design and will be announced soon so that as you obtain sponsors for HSITP/New Smyrna shows and year end awards, your show fees are reduced!!!
- ◆ The early entry fee discount remains in 2019, however the basic entry fee has increased by \$1 for all entry fees *except for* medals and classics. This was necessary to help offset additional staffing and material costs which have increased significantly during 2018. Stall prices are changed to reflect same day arrival/departure pricing at \$45. and decreased by \$5.00 to \$60 for one or two night stays....ie; Fri/Sat, Sat/Sun or Fri-Sun.
- ◆ At this time there is one double pointed show planned in November.
- ◆ Year End awards have been expanded to include not only Champion and Reserve but now includes 8 ribbons. Year End award eligibility requires participation within the class or division in 4 out of the 6 shows. All Hunter Classics and Equitation Medals including Marshall & Sterling classes carry their own eligibility for special year end award recognition through 8 ribbons. In addition, Model Horse and Model Pony are now eligible.
- ◆ Show management is exploring the option of providing the New Smyrna Year End awards at a special function held in the local area at a luncheon or convenient location, for greater recognition and emphasis on our New Smyrna riders. We would like to offer a special event coordinator’s opportunity to someone who’d like to step forward and assist us with this event to include venue selection and program design....

JUDGES FOR 2019 include Jan Massarro “R”, Patti Anderton, “R”, Bill Talbert “R”, Mark Wonderly “r” and two other USEF rated judges TBD.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Stall reservations taken by receipt of valid entry only.** Entry fees are \$13.00 per class for pre-entries received prior to 8pm on Sunday before show. \$15.00 per class after Sunday 8pm and additional \$10 late fee applied for forms rec'd after Tuesday. Office/Insurance per horse/rider entry \$20.00. EMT fee \$10.00 per rider. \$15.00 ship in grounds fee per day for horses without a stall. 26 RV sites \$35.00 per day. Sales tax applicable to stalls and RV sites. Marshall & Sterling/SEMF classes are \$25.00 and have special ribbons and awards. All horses must compete in min of 1 division in the show or a \$50 non-compete fee applies plus stall or ship in. You must have a current show back number visible to enter any arena, including Friday schooling. No numbers issued until a signed entry blank by parent/guardian has been received and the secretary has received an open check or form of payment. **Current Negative Coggins info req'd. on entry.**
- **Parents/legal documented guardians (not just the trainer) signature must be present on the entry form (if rider is under 18) waiver before a back number is issued for any riding or schooling. Riders 18 and over must complete and sign the entry waiver.**
- **100 Stalls Available at \$45.00 per stall FOR SAME DAY ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE. All others are \$60 per stall ie; Fri/Sat or for Sat/Sun or Fri-Sunday. Stalls open Friday at 10 am. SCHOOLING IN ARENA ON FRIDAY AVAILABLE 10-5:00PM. Stalls Assigned in the order of entries received- HORSES SHOWING IN DIVISIONS 2 + DAYS WILL GET STABLING PRIORITY. NO SHAVINGS SOLD AT THIS SHOW. Track stalls MAY not be split in the office, please designate who to be billed.**
- Paddock Master will limit # of riders and time in schooling. You must have a current show number to school.
- Payment: Check or cash, and VISA/MasterCard accepted with \$10 ETF fee. NSF fee \$50.00.
- Schooling fences may be set out on grass by arena.
- Show management reserves the right to refuse entry, combine or cancel classes for any reason.
- All dogs must be on leash! 3 minute gate call strictly enforced.
- **Boots, breeches, polo shirts.** USEF/ASTM approved headgear required for all mounted participants
- Open Walk Trot classes on Sunday morning are open to all.

2019 “SIMPLY SCHOOLING” SHOW CLASS SPECIFICATIONS—PLEASE READ!!

To award a daily high point Champion and Reserve, there must be an average of 3 participants with points in the division. In 2019, year end awards will also be provided in December to the Champion and Reserve Champion winners in each of the divisions and the Hunter Classics and Equitation Medals. **8 Ribbons will be awarded, provided there are riders that meet the eligibility requirements. Riders and / or horses/ponies must have competed in their division a minimum of 4 shows to be eligible for year end award. Should there be a tie, the rider who has attended the most shows in that division/category will place higher.**

Adults may ride ponies in any division other than Children’s Pony.

Walk—Riders age 4 to 8.—age of rider as of Jan 1 of show year. Trainers and or assistant may be present in the arena with the rider. The judge joins the riders in the arena and may offer guidance and encouragement following each class. Using one half of the arena, rider to demonstrate proper position and understanding of basic equitation along with simple direction of horse or pony. Walk Trot Leadline requires the handler to clip a lead onto the mount, and trot round a 20m circle while the rider demonstrates a posting trot, proper diagonals not required. In Poles, the rider shows guidance and proper position over 2 ground poles 5m apart

Walk Trot, Walk Trot Crossrails.—age of rider as of Jan 1 of show year. Riders not to have cantered in a horse show. No cross entry into or from other divisions other than walk trot classes, Sunday’s Open Schooling Walk Trot, Walk trot canter 1 @ Time, Crossrail Jumper. Age Group Saturday W/Trot classes’ points are reported by rider and the rider may ride any horse or pony throughout the show year and maintain their points.

Pleasure Horse/Pony—Horses to walk, trot/canter each direction of the arena while rider maintains a light contact or a loose rein. The fun Versatility class may ask for movements that show the mounts obedience to the rider’s commands and demonstrated usefulness.

Green Horse/Pony. A horse or pony in their first 2 years of horse showing at any show. The **Schooling Walk Trot Classes** on Sunday morning are also great for the Greenies!!!

Short/Long Stirrups Hunter and Equitation: These divisions have two age groups for year end award unless combined by show management (Short is 12 & under, Long is 13 & over) . Simple 18” verticals and gates w/flower boxes. High Point for Hunter, and High Point for Equitation.

Intermediate Rider: Fences 2’ with no oxers. Rider not to have jumped over 2’3” in a show, Rider may cross enter the jumpers 2’ and lower , Pleasure, and Crossrail and the Schooling Hunter division. No cross entry into Modified or Short/Long Stirrups . High Point for Hunter, and High Point for Equitation.

Children’s Pony Hunter —Small/Med to jump 2’, Large to jump 2’3” , ridden by juniors.

Open Crossrails, Schooling, Training, Open 2’6” Hunter, Performance Hunter —horse or pony ridden by pro or amateur—open divisions. Simple changes allowed in Schooling Hunter and Open Crossrails.

Modified Hunter/Rider—Open to amateur riders of any age who have not competed/jumped higher than 2’6” .” Should entries warrant, may be split 14 under and 15 & up. *Modified riders may not cross enter into Low Children’s/Adult unless they choose to move up that day .* Points based on the horse in hunter, rider in equitation

Pre-Children’s/Adult Hunter/Equitation— ridden by adults or juniors of amateur status, Separate high point for hunter and equitation.

Jumpers—open to any horse/pony ridden by amateur or professional. Both courses are Time/Faults. Crossrails, and 18” Jumpers are judged on the basis of Optimum Time, (who comes closest to the optimum time as chosen by the judge—and excessive speed will be penalized) **Jumpers....To be able to provide a champion and reserve each show, we’ve added a Jumper Equitation round, so there are now 3 rounds at each fence height..** Jumper Equitation is judged both on the rider’s equitation, and their demonstrated ability to ride the course effectively and efficiently, staying within the time allowed for completion.

****The progression of rider entries in Hunters/Equitation over a period of time usually goes Walk, Walk Trot, Short/Long Stirrups, Intermediate Rider, Modified Rider, Low Children’s / Adult and lastly, Children’s /Adult. Once a rider has moved up into another fence height or division such as Short/Long Stirrups into Intermediate, it is not appropriate to move backwards ie; show again in Short/Long Stirrups. It is the rider’s responsibility to read the class specs and contact the show management if any questions remain prior to making their entries. It is not the show secretary’s role to proof entries for eligibility. Riders and Trainers are responsible for the validity of their entries. Should an issue be brought forward to show management by an exhibitor it will be investigated and may involve both parties within the issue.**

The following divisions are eligible for High Point Champion and Reserve at each show and year end award of Champion and Reserve with 8 ribbons awarded: Must show in 4 out of 6 shows for year end award...
