GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Stall reservations taken by receipt of valid entry only.** Entry fees are \$14.00 per class for pre-entries received prior to 8pm on Sunday before show. \$2 added per class after Sunday 8pm . Entry fees may be offset by volunteer hours. Office/insurance per horse/rider entry \$20.00 plus EMT fee \$10.00. *\$15.00 ship in grounds fee per day for horses without a stall.* 30amp RV sites \$35.00 per day. 2 50 amp sites \$40.00 per day. Test 321-693-5551 to reserve RV sites and put on entry. Sales tax applicable to stalls and RV sites. **All horses in a stall must compete in min of 1 division per day (3 classes) (Fri/Sat or Sat/Sun) in the show or a \$50 non-compete fee applies plus stall or ship in.** You must have a current show back number visible to ride on the showgrounds including Friday schooling. No numbers issued until a signed entry blank by parent/guardian has been received and the secretary has received an open check or form of payment . **Current Negative Coggins info req'd. on entry.**
- **Parents/legal documented guardians (not just the trainer) signature must be present on the entry form (if rider is under 18) waiver before a back number is issued for any riding or schooling. Riders 18 and over must complete and sign the entry waiver.**
- **Unless availability permits, stalls will not be issued to non showing horses. 100 Stalls Available at \$45.00 per stall FOR SAME DAY ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE. All others are \$75 per stall ie; Fri/Sat or for Sat/Sun or Fri-Sunday. Stalls open Friday at 11 am. SCHOOLING IN ARENA ON FRIDAY AVAILABLE 12-7:00PM. HORSES SHOWING IN DIVISIONS BOTH DAYS WILL GET STABLING PRIORITY. NO SHAVINGS SOLD AT THIS SHOW Track stalls MAY not be split in the office, please designate who to be billed.**
- Paddock Master will limit # of riders and time in schooling. You must have a visible current show number to school.
- Payment: Check or cash, and VISA/MasterCard accepted with \$10 ETF fee. Returned check fee (NSF fee) \$50.00.
- Show management reserves the right to refuse entry, combine or cancel classes for any reason.
- All dogs must be on leash! 3 minute gate call strictly enforced.
- **Boots, breeches, polo shirts.** USE/ASTM approved head-gear required for all mounted participants
- Open Schooling classes on Sunday morning are open to all.



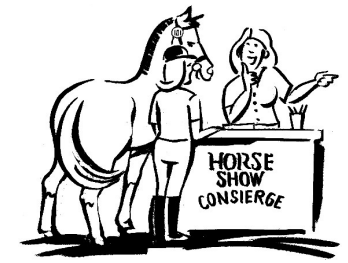

Horse Shows in the Park LLC is taking into consideration the published guidelines of the CDC and State and local authorities. The following show protocols associated with COVID 19 are in place and may be subject to change and communicated as necessary.

- Facial coverings ie; masks/bandannas are not required of those exhibitors mounted while on a horse. Should the exhibitor desire to wear a mask/bandanna it will not be counted against their performance in any way.
- It is recommended each rider bring a facial covering to use while in crowded areas or at the show office and an ample supply of hand sanitizer and personal protection items they feel necessary by personal choice for use throughout the show ie; at the barns, arenas , door handles, etc.
- Trainer and rider only allowed within the ingate area. All others will be asked to step outside the ingate enclosed area. Horses within the ingate area will be limited by gate personnel so as to demonstrate appropriate social distance. Strict rotations of 4 for all over fences classes.
- There will be no seating available arena side this show, but you may bring your own chairs and sit following socially distant responsible guidelines ie; six feet apart.
- Ring Status will be announced via the PA system.
- Entries and waivers should be signed, and either emailed or brought with you to the show. Emails of scanned entry forms can be sent to wittyshowsec@earthlink.net by the Sunday pre entry deadline. No mail in entries. Entries missing signatures, class and payment information, are not valid and will not be processed nor stalls issued.
- Do not come to the show office or ribbon/award areas with more than one person to wait in line. Social distance guidelines mandate 6' between customers..
- Entry/Account questions may be texted or called to the show secretary at 352-406-9886 before, during or after the show.

Horse Show Management may ask any individual to leave the Horse Show Property should that individual choose to willfully ignore published protocols and subsequent instruction

EMR, LLC, HSITP LLC RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND INDEMNIFICATION: I AGREE, in consideration for my participation in the Competition to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the competition with or without my horse, as a rider, handler, spectator, leasor, lease, owner, agent, coach/trainer or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor and I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involves inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death (Harm). 2021 “SIMPLY SCHOOLING” SHOW CLASS SPECIFICATIONS-**PLEASE READ!!**

To award a daily high point Champion and Reserve, there must be 3 or more participants in the division. Champion and Reserve must enter in all three classes in the division to qualify for the award. In 2021, year end awards will also be provided in each of the divisions and the Hunter Classic and Equitation Medals. **8 Ribbons will be awarded, provided there are riders that meet the eligibility requirements. Riders and/or horses/ponies must have competed in their division or Medal/Classic a minimum of 4 shows to be eligible for year end award. Should there be a tie, the rider who has attended the most shows in that division/category and (if applicable) possess the highest # pts over fences will place higher. Adults may ride ponies in any division.**

Walk—Riders age 4 to 8 or documented para-equestrian.—age of rider as of Jan 1 of show year. Trainers and/or assistant may be present in the arena with the rider. The judge joins the riders in the arena and may offer guidance and encouragement following each class. Using one half of the arena, rider to demonstrate proper position and understanding of basic equitation along with simple direction of horse or pony. Walk Trot Leadline requires the handler to clip a lead onto the mount, and trot round a 20m circle while the rider demonstrates a posting trot, proper diagonals not required. In Poles, the rider shows guidance and proper position over 2 ground poles 5m apart. No cross entry into other classes.

Pre-Walk Trot—age 8 and under as of Jan 1 of show year or documented para equestrian. . Designed for riders moving up out of Walk division but not ready yet to trot the entire arena. Trainers/handlers requested to be in the arena but not alongside. 1/2 of arena will be used. No cross entry into Walk Trot 9 under div. unless moving up.

Walk Trot, Walk Trot Crossrails—age of rider as of Jan 1 of show year. Riders not to have cantered in a horse show. No cross entry into or from other divisions other than Green Horse Walk Trot classes, Sunday’s Open Schooling Walk Trot, Walk trot canter 1 @ Time, Crossrail Jumper. Points are reported by rider and the rider may ride any horse or pony throughout the show year and maintain their points.

Pleasure Horse/Pony—Horses to walk, trot/canter each direction of the arena while rider maintains a light contact or a loose rein. The fun Versatility class may ask for movements that show the horses’ obedience to the rider’s commands and demonstrated usefulness.

Green Horse/Pony. A horse or pony in their first 2 years of horse showing at any show. The **Open Schooling Classes** on Sunday morning are also great for the Greenies!!!

Short/Long Stirrups Hunter and Equitation: These divisions may have two age groups for year end award unless combined by show management (Short is 12 & under, Long is 13 & over) . Simple 18” verticals and gates w/flower boxes. High Point for Hunter, and High Point for Equitation. No cross entry into Jumpers above 18”

Intermediate Rider: Fences 2’ with no oxers. Rider not to have jumped over 2’3” in a show, Rider may cross enter the jumpers 2’ and lower . Green Horse, Sunday Equitation, Pleasure, and Open Sat Crossrails and the Open Schooling Sunday division. No cross entry into Modified or Short/Long Stirrups . High Point for Hunter, and High Point for Equitation.

Open Crossrails, Schooling, Training, HSITP Hunter —horse or pony ridden by pro or amateur—open divisions. Simple changes allowed in Schooling Hunter and Open Crossrails.

Modified Rider Equitation—Open to amateur riders of any age who have not competed/jumped higher than 2’6” . *Modified riders may not cross enter into Pre Children’s/Adult unless they choose to move up that show..* Points based on the horse in hunter, rider in equitation

Low Children’s/Adult Hunter/Equitation— ridden by adults or juniors of amateur status, Separate high point for hunter and equitation. Fence heights offered are 2’6” and 2’9”

Jumpers—open to any horse/pony ridden by amateur or professional. Courses are Time/Faults. Excessive speed as deemed by the judge may be penalized 8 seconds. **Jumpers....To be able to provide a champion and reserve each show, we’ve added a third Jumper Equitation round 2’6 and below, and a third round at 2’9” and 3’ so there are now 3 rounds at each fence height.** Jumper Equitation is judged both on the rider’s equitation, and their demonstrated ability to ride the course effectively and efficiently, staying within the time allowed for completion. **Year end high point awards for 2’ and below are based on the rider’s points in each division, so a rider may ride multiple horses during the show year and not lose points.**

****The progression of rider entries in Hunters/Equitation over a period of time usually goes Walk, Walk Trot, Short/Long Stirrups, Intermediate Rider, Modified Rider, Low Children’s / Adult and lastly, 3’ Children’s /Adult. Once a rider has moved up into another fence height or division such as Short/Long Stirrups into Intermediate, it is not appropriate to show again in Short/Long Stirrups. It is the rider’s responsibility to read the class specs and contact the show management if any questions remain prior to making their entries. It is not the show secretary’s role to proof entries for eligibility. Riders and Trainers are responsible for the validity of their entries. Should an issue be brought forward to show management by an exhibitor it will be investigated and may involve both parties.**

The following divisions are eligible for High Point Champion and Reserve at each show and year end award of Champion and Reserve with 8 ribbons awarded to eligible riders: Must show in your division for award in 4 out of 8 shows for year end award...the 4 show minimum will be strictly adhered to in 2021. If a division is combined with another at 4 or more shows during the year than it will be combined for year end award.
