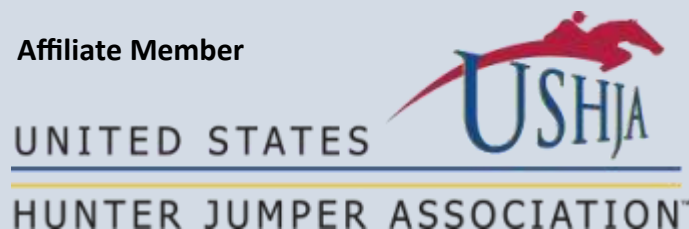

We may be using the Racetrack areas west of the Bistro, as that surface has been irrigated daily during these drought conditions and may present the best, level footing for our competitors. **D1-9:00-10:00 AM**

**\$250 Tenny's Custom Saddlery Field Hunter Derby-2'6"**

The course has been designed by our judge Shannon Bejarano to flow over approximately 10 jumps, excluding Crossrailer & Ground Poles which have a shorter course, with options to showcase jumping ability, obedience to rider's aids, movement, & ease of covering ground in an efficient & safety. A great opportunity to wear your shadbelly for the photos@

**D2-10:00-11:00 AM**

**\$100 "Winner Take All" Bona Fide Farms 2'3" Utility Hunter**

The "Utility Hunter" may be asked in addition to jumping an abbreviated course, to halt from a hand gallop, stand on the buckle, jump quietly at hand over a small branch at the end of the course, stop & drink a refreshment, pick up an invitation & place it in your hunt coat, cross a wooden bridge & open/close a free standing gate. 3 extra points for obvious good sense of humor & sportsmanship.

**D3- \$100 "Winner Take All" Grand Oaks Derby Prix-** at your fence height. A combination of Hunt Country Classic fences & stadium jumps. Judged in part on classic hunter manners, pace, brilliance, boldness and accuracy over a designated course. **Speed not to count**, judged on optimum time & pace at 350 ppm.

**D4-11:00-12:00-Hunt Fields Mini Derby 18"-21"**

Short/Long Stirrups may enter. Same course as D1 but smaller jumps.

**D5. 1:00-2PM-Hunt Teams Competition** at your selected height -(must specify height on entry!) Team of 2, each rider must enter and designate a Team Name. Run Open card at your teams designated height slot. A team of 2 riders start the course from the designated start box and establish a hunting pace, 4 strides apart. Halfway through the course the lead horse falls back or circles to become the second horse and they continue to the last fence where each horse jumps a jump or pole in the option jump at the same time (2 abreast) and then pulling down to a trot back to the ring steward exiting at a walk 2 abreast through the start box.

**D6. 2-3PM-Bounder Beagle Crossrails Derby**

Open to all, walk trotters may enter, shorter course-D6 and D7 to be ridden at a trot or canter, if riding D5 hunt team over crossrails, the last fence may be two jumps/poles side by side. These two classes are judged on pace, consistency, safety, jumping ability, obedience and adherence to the team distance/accuracy, change of team lead, and way of going. Riders jumping or behaving in an unsafe manner will be whistled off the course and excused.

**D7. 3-4PM Hilltoppers Pole Course** Open to all, and walk trotters may enter, shorter course. A shortened course with a few fun challenges for horse and rider. To be ridden at a trot. No pros. No cross entry to any other derby. Judged on manners, style, consistent pace, accuracy, and ability to follow and complete the course. Specified time limit to be posted.

**TG1-12:30 PM-SATURDAY'S "A Taste of Elegance" Tailgaters Competition. (Important to pre enter!)** Tailgaters entered in the "Taste of Elegance" Tailgating competition will be judged on Elegance, Presentation, Traditionalism, Food/Drink quality, Attire and Overall Hunt Country Ambiance. Judging will be held at 12:30, Tents will be allowed if set up and tied down prior to 8:30AM, weather permitting. Judges will be Shannon Bejarano, Kacy Fashik Tipton, Grand Oaks GM, and TBD (under invite). Tailgate exhibitors may park along the fence line in a designated area.. Farm/Trainer signage encouraged!

**MD1- 12 NOON-SUNDAY'S Mother's Day Hat & Equine at Hand Parade Competition.** To be held on Sunday, Mother's Day at noon in the Triple Crown Arena. Dress up your Mother and/or family members (and her favorite Horse/Pony if you like) in a Hat and Fancy Competition with Parade. Our judge will select the most elegant, tasteful and traditional Mother's Day Hat and attire for both with a special award to the winner! (and LOTS of pictures)

## SCHOOLING INFORMATION

COURSES will be posted Friday at the Huntfields Outside Arena. The course will be open for walking and trotting only to preserve footing on Friday 11-6pm-**NO JUMPING!!!** Only those riders entered in the Derbies will be allowed on course Friday. The Hunt Utility obstacles however will be available for schooling during this time, such as, the gate, bridge, mailbox. The hunt fences are simple, natural and inviting. Most of the fences you have already jumped at other HSITP shows. Nothing complicated, just Beautiful and FUN!

**1. ## **OPTIMUM TIME INFORMATION**

**At HSITP, we score and place our Jumpers that jump Ground Poles up to .60m (2'), on the basis of “Optimum Time”. This is a time that is as a result of cantering the course at an efficient speed of generally 350 meters per minute. Each course is wheeled, and then a calculation is made to obtain the Optimum Time for that course. Per USEF guidelines, 4 seconds is then deducted from that calculated time.**

**Times of completion are noted by the judge, and then the class is placed according to the riders who came closest to the optimum time, either higher or lower and taking into consideration any faults incurred due to downed rails.**

**The Optimum time approach is good for the lower fence height levels and provides an emphasis on getting to each fence accurately and efficiently, at a good even cantering pace. We DON'T believe a “time and faults” approach works at the lower levels because it encourages dangerous, fast riding at the lower levels of rider proficiency, which may lead to falls and an unsafe performance. This Optimum Time approach has been adopted by USEF at levels up to and including .85m (2'9”).**
